A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,933,000 BONDS OF THE TOWN OF RENSSELAERVILLE, ALBANY COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY THE COST OF THE INCREASE AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE FACILITIES OF RENSSELAERVILLE WATER DISTRICT, IN THE TOWN OF RENSSELAERVILLE, ALBANY COUNTY, NEW YORK.

**Class of objects or purposes:**

the planning, design, construction of and installation of equipment, appurtenances, and incidental site and other improvements and expense in connection with the installation of water meters, replacement of the water storage tank, water treatment system, pump station and the development and construction of a new ground water source for the Rensselaerville Water District

**Period of probable usefulness:**

40 years

**Maximum estimated cost:**

\$3,933,000

**Amount of obligations to be issued:**

\$3,933,000 bonds
